

Substantial Amendment to 2018 Annual Action Plan

Community Development Block Grant Program

The Annual Action Plan (AAP) details the programs and projects the city wishes to fund with its Community Development Block Grant allocation. In 2018, the AAP included \$161,428 for the implementation of recommendations from the Community and Senior Centers Rehabilitation Feasibility Study. Costs associated with accessibility improvements to the facility or improvements in to the area of the facility dedicated to senior programming are eligible to be reimbursed with CDBG funds. However, due to the timing of the completion of the study and the capital improvement planning process, the city will not be able to expend the funds and meet the timeliness test. An amendment to the 2018 AAP to reallocate \$161,428 from the Community and Senior Center renovation project to infrastructure improvements in Old Town Lenexa, specifically the purchase of street lights leased from KCPL and replacing the street lights with energy-efficient LED street lights is proposed.

A public hearing was held on June 4, 2019 at the regularly scheduled City Council meeting, and the public comment period on this substantial amendment is from June 5, 2018 to July 5, 2019.
