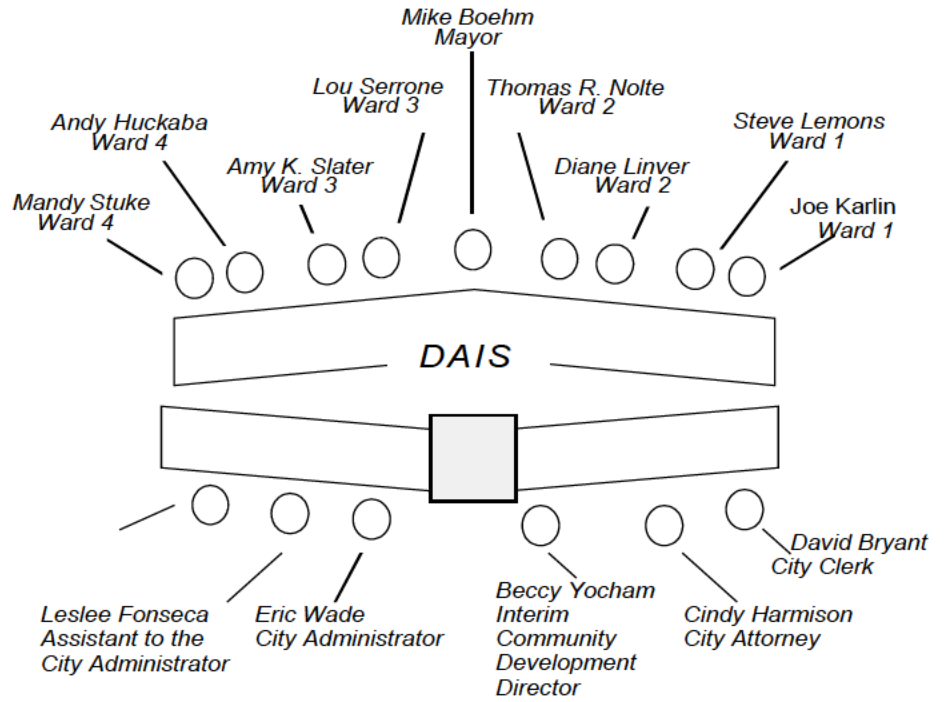
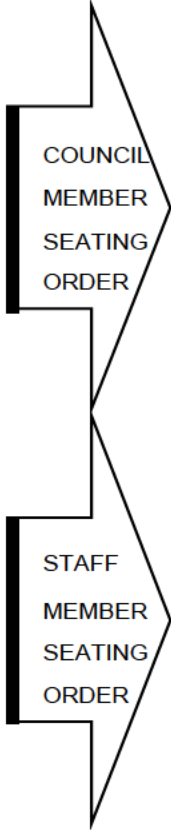

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**SUBJECT:** Community Standards Division Update

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**ACTION NEEDED:**

The Governing Body will receive an update on activities in the Community Standards division.

**PROJECT BACKGROUND/DESCRIPTION:**

In July 2011, the Governing Body received a memorandum update on the code enforcement and rental licensing programs. The memorandum indicated a more detailed analysis of both programs would occur in fall 2011, and an update would be provided to the Governing Body at that time.

Staff has spent several months evaluating code enforcement and rental licensing to increase the division's customer service focus, responsiveness, and consistency in application of ordinances.

We intend to review the following areas with the Governing Body at the Committee of the Whole meeting:

- Code enforcement overview (ordinances we enforce, inspection types, typical timeframes, notification requirements)
- Inspection updates
- Weed and nuisance abatement process
- Rental licensing and inspection program review
- Staffing plan

We look forward to sharing the progress of the division with you and welcome your input to ensure we are meeting the expectations of the Governing Body.
