

Dumpster Days E-Waste Recycling Information

Electronic waste will now be accepted during Dumpster Days. All electronic waste will be transported to Extreme Recycling in Topeka Kansas. Extreme Recycling has a "no landfill" policy and will recycle, refurbish, and/or remarket electronic items. They currently serve on the Kansas Organization of Recyclers (KOR) Board of Directors.

Extreme Recycling will accept most items with a power cord and/or containing a circuit board. A \$15 fee will be charged for each TV and monitor to cover recycling and transportation fees. The following items are will be accepted for recycling:
