Smoke Alarms

Yes/No We have one smoke alarm on every level of the home and inside and outside each sleeping area.

Yes/No We test and clean our smoke alarms every month.

Yes/No All of our smoke alarm batteries have been replaced in the last year.

Yes/No All of our smoke alarms are less than 10 years old.

Cooking Safety

Yes/No Our cooking area free from items that can catch fire

Yes/No An adult always stays in the kitchen when the stove in being used.

Electrical & Appliance Safety

Yes/No We do not have any electrical cords under rugs.

Yes/No Our electrical cords are not frayed or cracked.

Yes/No All of our appliances are plugged directly into wall outlets.

Yes/No Our clothes dryer lint filter and venting system are clean.

Candle Safety

Yes/No Our candles are in sturdy, fire-proof containers that won't be tipped over.

Yes/No We always put out candles before going to bed or leaving the room.

Yes/No We never leave children and pets unattended with candles.

Carbon Monoxide Alarms

Yes/No We have a carbon monoxide alarm on each level of our home.

Yes/No Our carbon monoxide alarms are less than 7 years old.

Smoking Safety

Yes/No All of my family members who smoke only buy fire-safe cigarettes and smoke outside.

Yes/No All matches and lighters are secured out of children's sight.

Yes/No Our ashtrays are large, deep, and kept away from items that can catch fire.

Yes/No The ashtrays are emptied into a container that will not burn.

Heating Safety

Yes/No Our chimney and furnace are cleaned and inspected yearly.

Yes/No Our furniture and other items that can catch fire are at least 3 feet from fireplaces, wall heaters, and space heaters.

Yes/No Our fireplace and barbecue ashes are placed outdoors in a covered metal container at least 3 feet from anything that can catch fire.

Yes/No We never use extension cords with space heaters.

Yes/No Our heaters are approved by a national testing laboratory and have tip-over shut-off function.

Home Escape Plan

Yes/No My family knows two ways out of each room.

Yes/No My family knows to crawl low to the floor when escaping to avoid toxic smoke.

Yes/No We know if there's a fire in our house we get out and stay out.

Yes/No Our meeting place is near the front of our home so firefighters know where we are.

Yes/No Everyone in my family knows where our meeting place is.

Yes/No We practice our fire escape plan.

Every "no" answer endangers your home and loved ones and should be corrected IMMEDIATELY!
