To the Members of the Planning Committee for Lenexa, Kansas –

My name is Jane Barboza, and I use to live in Lenexa, Kansas, in the late 80's. We moved our family from northern Ohio due to a job relocation, and we picked Lenexa to be our new home from many other cities in the community. Lenexa was warm, welcoming, and so friendly and it was surrounded by farmland to the west – a beautiful place to raise a family. Due to another move that took us out of state, our family left Lenexa but found ourselves lucky enough to return to Kansas a few years later. At that time, I came back as a single parent with three small kids and couldn't afford to return to the same subdivision that we have lived in before.

I was lucky enough to find a job in Overland Park and eventually find housing at the time nearby. The point of that story is that the world has changed a great deal, in the years since we purchased our first home in Lenexa and now, I have three adult kids who would like those same opportunities to have their dreams become reality. This new world is quickly proving that a young single adult or a small family struggle to find a place to call home and to have their dreams realized. The Habitat KC Program is that dream for so many, who wouldn't even come close without great programs like Habitat. Habitat isn't a new idea – it has existed since September 1976. Habitat has been changing communities for over 50 years. What is stopping this community from accepting this wonderful, life-fulfilling dream? Isn't the main goal of a great city to incorporate people who want to stay in their community and raise their families in the same places that they grew up in? I can promise you that these communities would be blessed to have them.

We are talking about people who want to give back to their communities and be included along with other tax-paying citizens. But with rising costs on everything – home ownership is pricing them out of that luxury. Don't you want hard working people, people who love their community, to have a shot like you did, to be a homeowner? People will be grateful to be included because the community sees them – what more can you ask for?

As far as the nearby park is considered - it isn't going away, they are merely asking for 17 acres (near the existing park), that have sat vacant and can now be transformed into a wonderful subdivision of smaller but affordable housing for that area. These properties will not affect current property values due to the land-trust/land-bank model but will only enhance the already existing properties. Taking the time to visit the Habitat KC Pathway

Project may help you visually imagine and see the pride and joy of this newly created community rising from nothing and may help you imagine what is possible for Lenexa. I can't think of a better spotlight on Lenexa as this friendly city who welcomes all to be a part of their community!

Let the next words you hear from Habitat KC be, "Lenexa welcomes you, home"!

Good evening. Thank you for allowing me to offer my comments tonight.

My name is Kevin Butler. I am a homeowner in Lenexa, Kansas. I am here tonight to speak in support of the Habitat for Humanity Lenexa Affordable Housing Project.

I support and admire the work of Habitat for Humanity. I have personally seen the effect of local non-profit home repair and modification service organizations first hand by volunteering for many years with Christmas in October and Hope Builders KC where teams of community members come together to repair and improve homes for people who needed help badly. I have seen many families crying tears of joy after volunteers have made home improvements and left those families with homes that are safe, clean, and livable without despair or shame.

What Habitat is proposing here is not just to create a low-income neighborhood.

It is to create a permanent community of affordable housing following a well-planned concept that has been successfully used many times before in other areas.

It is to provide homeownership opportunities for working families who want to live and raise their families in Lenexa.

Applicants who attain these single-family homes are carefully selected and vetted based upon specific qualifications; here are a few:

- 3. They must provide proof of two-years of steady, verifiable, and qualified income**
- 4. One year of good rental history**
- 5. They must pass criminal background and sex-offender checks**
- 6. They must have the ability to pay closing costs for the mortgage**
- 7. They must provide proof of U.S. Citizenship or permanent resident status.**

Lenexa is strengthened when teachers, first responders, healthcare workers, city employees, and young growing families can afford to live in the community they serve. I urge you to approve this proposal and help Lenexa remain a place where stability, opportunity, and belonging can all grow together.

I am here tonight in strong support of the proposed 50-home Habitat for Humanity project in Lenexa, Kansas.

Attainable housing has become one of the most pressing challenges facing Johnson County. Today, the average sales price of a home in Lenexa is approximately **\$561,140**, placing homeownership increasingly out of reach for first-time buyers. Combined with historically low housing inventory, this environment makes it extraordinarily difficult for working families to establish roots in the communities where they live and work.

The need is clear. Currently, **40% of renters in Johnson County spend more than 30% of their income on housing**, leaving little room for savings, education, healthcare, or long-term financial stability. This is not sustainable for families or for the long-term health of our communities.

The Kansas City Regional Association of REALTORS® has worked closely with Habitat for Humanity for many years and proudly supports its mission of providing attainable housing for all. Good Morning,

I wanted to introduce myself and weigh in on the HFH project on Clare Rd in Lenexa. My name is Doug Claussen, I am a developer, builder and real estate broker that has lived in Lenexa since the early 2000's. I have developed and built in Lenexa since 2006. My wife and I raised our 5 children in Lenexa. I was one of the original builders in Arbor Lake back in 2006. I developed the 5 plats at Prairie View at Creekside Woods. Additionally, we built a good amount of those homes. Our office in Lenexa is located at 11076 Strang Line Rd. I also own 70 acres at 91st and Mize Rd and 262 acres at 96th and Cedar Niles Rd. So I would consider myself a stakeholder in Lenexa and very invested in that specific area of the city.

My career spans 30 years as a developer, builder and broker, so I do understand real estate. My position on this development is very simple, this location is NOT the right spot for Habitat for Humanity. Location is one of the most important aspects of real estate. Hence the reason why we don't build bars or liquor stores next to schools and daycares. It is why we don't build residential homes next to heavy industrial uses. We tend to put higher density residential as buffers between traffic and lower density residential. My point is **location matters**. My knowledge of Habitat for Humanity is that they have been successful at rebuilding aging housing stock and by building new homes in areas that need improvement. They are not a traditional developer who builds market rate product in a growth residential area. I believe there are areas in Lenexa that could be greatly improved by Habitat for Humanity. My concern is why would we experiment by putting them in an area where their product could hinder future growth, rather than enhance the location.

Lenexa does need all housing types including multifamily, starter homes, step up homes, estate homes and that includes housing product like Habitat for Humanity. It is critically important that all these housing types be located in the right places that promote their success and improve the surrounding area. This specific location just doesn't make sense.

I hope that as a City Council member you will consider this professional point of view, and vote/represent on behalf of the Lenexa stakeholders in the area around 91st and Clare.

Thank you for your email.

As an organization, Habitat for Humanity of Kansas City values the safety of children and other vulnerable individuals, our employees, volunteers and the homeowners we serve. We want to take prudent measures to protect our human and material resources.

Habitat for Humanity of Kansas City requires that sexual offender registry and criminal background checks be conducted for all homeowner applicants and adult members of their household.

Any application that does not include the necessary consent for background checks will be denied.

The following list provides some examples in which Habitat for Humanity may, within its sole discretion, determine an individual to be ineligible for homeownership:

- sexual offenses
- violent crimes;
- felony property theft
- other crimes that could threaten the health or safety of nearby residents.

We utilize guidance from Habitat International as well as local policy to determine ineligibility.

Regarding the Proposed Habitat for Humanity Development

1. The “Property Value” Myth

Claim

Affordable housing lowers nearby property values.

Fact

The majority of peer-reviewed research shows **no negative impact** on surrounding property values in strong, high-demand markets—especially when homes are owner-occupied and built on vacant land.

Supporting Research

- **Urban Institute – *Assessing the Impact of Affordable Housing on Nearby Property Values: Alexandria, VA***

Finding: In a high-cost, high-demand market, affordable housing built on vacant land resulted in a **0.09% increase** in nearby property values.

Why it applies: Alexandria’s housing dynamics are comparable to Johnson County; the study examined integrated, non-blighted developments.

2. “Those People” Are Essential Workers

Claim

Residents will be unemployed, transient, or unstable.

Fact

Habitat for Humanity income caps are designed to serve **working families earning below the median but above poverty**, including many essential workers already employed in the community.

Finding: The “low-income” cap for a family of four encompasses teachers, police officers, EMTs, CNAs, and logistics workers.

3. Commonly Cited Counter-Arguments (and Why They Do Not Apply to Habitat for Humanity)

Opposition frequently cites studies involving **Section 8 rentals, LIHTC developments, or large apartment complexes**. These are materially different from Habitat's **owner-occupied, single-family homes**.

A. Section 8 / High-Income Neighborhood Effect

- **Housing Policy Debate – *The Impact of Neighbors Who Use Section 8 Certificates on Property Values***

Finding: In some high-value neighborhoods, **clustered Section 8 rental units** within 500 feet were associated with modest declines in property values.

Why it does NOT apply:

- Focuses on **rental vouchers**, not homeownership
- Negative effects tied to **clustering**, not scattered sites
- Habitat homes are **owner-occupied, single-family**, and dispersed

Finding: LIHTC rental developments showed mixed effects—price increases in low-income areas and modest declines in some high-income areas, often driven by market perception during announcement or construction.

Why it does NOT apply:

- LIHTC developments are **large, multifamily rentals**
- Habitat builds **small-scale, owner-occupied homes**

C. Housing Concentration & Density Effects

- **NYU Furman Center for Real Estate & Urban Policy – Policy Review**
Finding: Negative impacts are most likely when affordable housing is **high-density, visually distinct, or heavily concentrated.**
Why it does NOT apply:
Habitat homes are **low-density, architecturally consistent,** and integrated into existing single-family neighborhoods.

- **Trulia Research – *There Goes the Neighborhood?***
Finding: In 18 of 20 markets, no negative impact was observed. Declines occurred only in **Boston and Cambridge**, extremely dense and land-constrained markets.
Why it does NOT apply:
Lenexa is neither land-constrained nor high-density.

4. Foreclosure & Long-Term Stability

Claim

Habitat homes will fall into disrepair or foreclosure.

Fact

Habitat homeowners demonstrate **exceptionally low foreclosure rates** due to sweat equity requirements and fixed-rate mortgages.

Supporting Research

- **Nonprofit Quarterly – *Habitat for Humanity Tries to Stem Foreclosures***
Finding: National Habitat foreclosure rates are **below 2%**, compared to historic subprime rates exceeding **15%**.
Explanation: Mandatory sweat equity and homeowner education create strong long-term stability.

Claim

Affordable housing brings crime.

Fact

Crime correlates with **concentrated poverty and neglect**, not with **owner-occupied affordable housing**.

- **Stanford Graduate School of Business – Diamond & McQuade (2019)**
Finding: LIHTC developments in higher-income areas resulted in **no increase or a decrease in crime**; in lower-income areas, crime decreased.
Explanation: Development replaces vacant land and increases “eyes on the street.”

Summary for the Record

- Property value impacts from **owner-occupied affordable housing in strong markets are neutral or positive.**
- Studies showing negative impacts focus on **rental, high-density, or clustered developments**, not Habitat homes.
- Habitat for Humanity serves **working families and essential workers**, not transient populations.
- Habitat homeowners show **exceptional long-term stability and extremely low foreclosure rates.**
- There is **no credible evidence** linking Habitat-style housing to increased crime.

Conclusion:

The proposed Habitat for Humanity development is supported by empirical research, aligns with best housing-policy practices, and poses **no demonstrated risk** to property values, safety, or neighborhood stability.

We live in The Timbers on the northwest corner of the roundabout at Clare and 91st. We built a house here specifically because of the park and wetlands across the street. We would really like to support this project, but as of now it is hard to do so.

We are in support of this because we believe our community should be open to people of all backgrounds and that enabling home ownership is extremely important. People are more important than property values. Some of the official public comments are very dehumanizing and frankly I am very ashamed that I share a neighborhood with people who are so full of hate.

Our concerns are primarily that this project does not address (and actually perpetuates) some of the foundational problems with suburban America. We need denser housing to create a tax base that can actually support our infrastructure. Why not condos or apartments?

Councilmembers,

For the benefit of the public record as this item advances to City Council, I respectfully request clarification regarding the residential classification framework referenced during the Planning Commission meeting and in staff materials.

Based on review of the City of Lenexa's Unified Development Code and residential construction standards, the City does not utilize a codified, citywide "Class A/B/C/D" classification system for residential development. Instead, Lenexa regulates residential compatibility through binding zoning districts (AG, RE, R-1, RP-1 through RP-5) and subdivision-specific minimum dwelling size requirements established at the time of plat approval.

This clarification is important to ensure that compatibility determinations relied upon by City Council are grounded in adopted standards and accurately reflect the surrounding residential context.

To the extent staff or applicants reference "Class C" or "Class D" classifications, clarification would be helpful as to the specific UDC provision, recorded plat, or adopted standard establishing that framework and how it is being applied across subdivision boundaries for purposes of adjacency analysis.

Subject: Follow-Up: Outstanding Process and Public Asset Stewardship Questions

Dear Councilmember Handley,

Thank you for your continued engagement and for confirming that my prior correspondence has been included in the public record.

Following the Planning Commission meeting and my review of the staff packet, I am writing to note—respectfully and for the record—that several substantive questions raised in my earlier correspondence remain unaddressed. While I understand the packet was structured to evaluate zoning and platting criteria, the issues outlined below relate to process integrity and fiduciary stewardship of City-owned land, rather than technical compliance alone.

Specifically, the materials and discussion to date do not address:

- Departure from historical land disposition practices.

The City has stated that the land will be developed regardless of the applicant. However, when this land was previously offered to private developers, the City required that all three parcels be purchased together. In this instance, the City is allowing Habitat for Humanity to purchase only one parcel. The packet does not explain why this longstanding safeguard was abandoned, how taxpayer value is being protected, or what analysis justified conveying City-owned land under materially different terms.

- Process integrity and timing concerns.

Public-record emails reflect coordination between City staff and the applicant months before neighborhood engagement, public notice, or formal Planning Commission review. Regardless of intent, the timing of these communications reasonably contributes to public perception concerns that are not addressed in the packet or during the hearing.

- Confirmation of residential development classifications in the surrounding area.

During the Planning Commission meeting, it was stated that the proposed Habitat for Humanity homes will be classified one level below adjacent residential development. However, the packet does not include documentation identifying the official residential development classifications for the immediately surrounding neighborhoods as a whole, nor the criteria and metrics used to determine those classifications. Clarification of the classifications applicable to the surrounding area and the proposed development would assist the public in understanding how compatibility and compliance were evaluated.

- Public asset stewardship and long-term park planning.

The City has acknowledged that a final park plan for this area is not expected until at least 2027. The packet does not analyze how rezoning and selling a portion of this City-owned land now affects future park planning options, public access, or long-term use of publicly held property.

- Site selection discretion.

County funding supporting this project is not site-specific and allows development elsewhere within Johnson County. The packet does not explain why this particular parcel of City-owned land was selected over alternative sites that would not require altering historical land disposition practices or reducing public land holdings.

I would also note, for context, that rising home values in the surrounding neighborhoods are not evidence of exclusion, but of long-term stability and successful public investment. A substantial majority of residents are middle-class families—nurses, teachers, librarians, public employees, and small business owners—who purchased modest homes over time and invested in their community. The City's responsibility in this context is not to act as a charitable intermediary, but to steward taxpayer-owned assets responsibly and apply standards uniformly. When public land is conveyed under altered practices, heightened scrutiny and clear justification are warranted.

Taken together, these unresolved issues raise reasonable questions about whether the City is departing from its own historical practices without sufficient justification, and whether its fiduciary obligations to taxpayers are being met.

I submit this correspondence to ensure the public record accurately reflects these outstanding concerns. I respectfully request clarification as to how and where these issues will be formally addressed as the application advances to City Council.

Good Afternoon Mayor and Ward 1 Council Members:

My name is Marc Sisk. My wife Carol and I live just across the street (Timbers at Clear Creek) from the proposed HFH project. We attended the recent Planning Commission Meeting last Monday evening and were very disappointed.

We provided written input to that meeting, but I did not speak at the recent meeting. I am regretting it so much not because of what I heard, but what I did not hear, that I am losing incredible amounts of sleep. I need to get the following off of my chest for my own sanity and I sincerely hope that you take the time to read and understand this. It is immensely important to us.

We are 69 and 72 respectively. We have worked a combined 100 years (a century) to be able to purchase a house in retirement at the Timbers of Clear Creek. I am a 24-year Army veteran (as part of my entire 50-year career), and my wife was a critical care nurse for 50 years. Our entire 100 years of employment was focused on defending this country and saving lives. We have certainly earned the right to live in nice home, in a more affluent neighborhood.

At the recent meeting, neither the HFH Spokesperson nor the City Planner Staffer mentioned HFH home prices. Obviously for a reason! It does not look good! They also only showed a sample of the largest floor plan, not the very smallest floor plan. Obviously for a reason! It does not look good!

Please picture what I am about to say and compare and contrast what amounts to complete opposites:

When you drive west on 83rd street you make that left turn onto Clair Rd. You drive a short way until you see a sign on the right that says something to the effect of Welcome to the Timbers at Clear Creek. Homes from the \$500K to \$800+K. Most homes in the Timbers far exceed the \$500K starting price point. If this HFH project is approved, you will then look directly across the street to see a similar sign that will read something to the effect of Future Site of Habitat for Humanity Low-income Housing. Homes from \$180K to \$250K (less than half of the median home price in Lenexa). What?

100 years of work versus 2 years of verifiable income to qualify for a HFH home. What? I had to work 17 years (in the military) before I could even afford a very small home. And it damn sure was not in any affluent neighborhood!

100 years of work compared to one year of good rental history to qualify for a HFH home. What?

100 years of work compared to two years since the completion of a bankruptcy or foreclosure to qualify for a HFH home. What? We would not be able to get a loan for our current house with that record!

100 years of work compared to 100 hours of sweat equity to qualify for a HFH home. What?

In what world does putting these two housing types together make any sense? They are not similar (as the City Planner Staffer stated); they are an order of magnitude different! And the passage of time will exacerbate this difference even more.

The city is very obviously trying to force a square peg into a board that is full of nothing but round holes, while trying to convince current homeowners that it is a good thing. This is absolutely not a good thing. All the neighboring communities have similar signs stating homes from \$500K to \$800+K. Even the duplexes being built to the west of St. James Academy are minimum \$600K. Duplexes, not separate homes.

The bottom line is that this housing project belongs in a like priced, like sized, and like appearance community. Not intermixed with substantially more affluent communities. We have absolutely no issues with HFH people. We were low income ourselves for a long time in our lives. We worked our way out of it. That process is called LIFE. Everyone needs to live it.

We have definite issues with intentionally causing the legacy for our children and their children to be undervalued. If you don't think that is true, then just think about first impressions for a moment. First (and potentially lasting) impressions for potential Timbers home buyers in the future will be impacted by an unregulated low-income community directly across the street from their future home. As in every single important decision in life (especially when it comes to the most important financial decision), first impressions mean everything and will 100% impact their decision-making process, potentially in a very negative way. Therefore, current homeowners will be negatively impacted by potential buyers turned off by the immediate, surrounding community. People are going to say out loud, who in the hell thought that this was a good idea?

Please let all of this sink in for a moment. What ethical, conscientious, and rational city planner would recommend this project for approval at this location? Would you want this foisted upon you? We think not.

Obviously, these thoughts and recommendations cannot fit into a rushed, three-minute speaking period of time. We appreciate your time reading and understanding our very important issues and concerns with this effort.

Dear Members of the City Council and Planning Commission,

I am writing to formally oppose the proposed 50-unit Habitat for Humanity development planned directly across from The Timbers at Clear Creek. My concerns are based on the project's significant zoning deviations, incompatibility with surrounding neighborhoods, long-term taxpayer risk created by City land ownership, and the removal of parkland/open space that was a major selling point for nearby homeowners.

1. The Requested Variances Create Lot Sizes Far Below Lenexa's Standards

The proposed development requires **extreme variances** that reduce lot sizes, widths, and setbacks far below the standards required in the surrounding R-1 and RP-1 districts.

Lenexa's Typical Standards for Single-Family Neighborhoods

These are the standards used for subdivisions like The Timbers:

Habitat Proposal vs. Lenexa Standards

The Habitat project proposes:

- **Lots under 4,000 sq ft**
- **Lot widths under 40 ft**
- **Minimal setbacks**
- **Density far exceeding surrounding subdivisions**

This density is more consistent with **RP-3 (garden apartment)** zoning, which is **not intended to be placed across from premium single-family neighborhoods**.

Why This Matters

- Variances are meant for *unique hardships*, not to force high-density development onto land that does not support it.

- Granting variances of this magnitude undermines the **integrity and fairness** of Lenexa's zoning code.
- No surrounding subdivision was granted variances even remotely close to this scale.
- This sets a **dangerous precedent** for future developers to demand similar concessions.

2. City Ownership of the Land Creates Long-Term Taxpayer Liability

Unlike typical developments, this project keeps the land under **City ownership**, creating ongoing financial and legal exposure for taxpayers.

This includes:

- Maintenance obligations for infrastructure and common areas
- Liability for injuries, disputes, or property conditions
- Administrative oversight burdens
- Potential costs if the development fails, stalls, or requires remediation

This is not a standard Habitat model. It is a **City-owned, City-risk development**, and taxpayers will bear the consequences indefinitely.

3. Loss of Parkland/Open Space Violates Buyer Reliance

For years, the land in question has been represented—both formally and informally—as **parkland, open space, and wetlands**. Many homeowners purchased in The Timbers at Clear Creek based on this understanding.

Removing this land:

- Violates reasonable reliance on City representations
- Reduces the environmental and recreational value of the Clear Creek corridor
- Alters the character of the area in a way that homeowners could not have anticipated

This is a **trust and transparency issue**, not merely a land-use decision.

4. Density and Variances Create Safety and Infrastructure Concerns

The project's compressed lot sizes and increased density will intensify:

- Traffic congestion on Clare Road

- On-street parking pressure
- Emergency vehicle access challenges
- Stormwater runoff risks near Clear Creek wetlands
- Wear on existing infrastructure

These are objective, measurable impacts that warrant serious consideration.

5. Governance and Oversight Risks

Because the City retains ownership of the land and the development relies on non-traditional financing and occupancy structures, there is no long-term enforcement mechanism for:

- Property upkeep
- Occupancy compliance
- Neighborhood standards
- Conflict resolution

This creates governance challenges that the City will be responsible for managing indefinitely.

Request

For these reasons, I respectfully request that the City Council and Planning Commission:

1. **Deny the requested variances** due to incompatibility with surrounding development and inconsistency with Lenexa's zoning standards.
2. **Reevaluate the appropriateness of City-owned residential land** in this location.
3. **Preserve the land as parkland or open space**, consistent with long-standing community expectations and the City's own planning principles.

These issues may implicate provisions of **Kansas conflict-of-interest law**, including:

- **K.S.A. 75-4304**, which prohibits public employees and officials from participating in matters where they hold a substantial interest
- **K.S.A. 75-4305**, which requires disclosure of substantial interests
- **K.S.A. 75-4306**, which prohibits the use of public office for personal financial gain

I am requesting:

1. That this complaint be formally logged and retained as part of the city's public record.
2. That the City Manager or appropriate administrative authority review the matter in light of the above statutes.
3. That any relevant documents, communications, or disclosures be preserved.

Thank you for ensuring proper handling of this filing in accordance with city procedures and Kansas law. Attached are emails documenting KSA ethics violations.

We, the undersigned residents and supporters of Lenexa, strongly oppose the rezoning and sale of public park land adjacent to the Clear Creek Wetland Trail and future Centennial Park.

This land is not unused—it is deeply valued by our community. Every day, families walk together, neighbors run and bike, children explore, people fish, and dogs play. Both the paved and unpaved trails are heavily used. This space is where our community connects, recharges, and finds peace away from daily life. Yet this irreplaceable public space is now at risk.

In addition to its recreational value, this land serves a critical ecological function. The Clear Creek Wetland area contains documented milkweed stands and a high presence of monarch butterflies, a species that has experienced population declines of over 80% in recent decades and is now listed as threatened. Monarchs migrate up to 3,000 miles across North America, and their survival depends entirely on the availability of intact milkweed habitat along these routes. Kansas plays a vital role in this migration, and the loss of remaining habitat has been identified by scientists and conservation organizations as one of the primary drivers of monarch decline.

Wetlands like Clear Creek are especially important for monarchs and other pollinators. They provide breeding grounds, shelter, and native vegetation while also delivering essential ecosystem services such as stormwater management, flood mitigation, water filtration, and wildlife support. Once destroyed, these ecosystems cannot be easily replaced.

Despite this, the City of Lenexa is considering rezoning and selling this land to Habitat for Humanity—land that was originally purchased using Park, Rain to Recreation, and Stormwater funds, all of which were intended to protect environmental resources and public green space. Selling this land threatens not only sensitive wildlife habitat, but also the public trust.

City officials have stated that the decision to sell this land was made years ago, between 2015 and 2018. However, this decision was never clearly or transparently communicated to the public. No “For Sale” sign was ever placed on the property, and the request for proposals was sent only to select developers rather than being made public. To residents, taxpayers, and voters, this land has always been presented—and experienced—as parkland.

For nearly a decade, the City’s own **Comprehensive Parks and Recreation Plan (2012–2024)** clearly depicted this entire area as parkland. That document remained publicly available and uncorrected for years, reinforcing the understanding that this land was intended to remain part of the City’s park system. At no point during that period was the public notified that the land shown as parkland in the City’s official planning documents was being considered for sale.

As recently as March 2025, the City continued to publicly promote this area as protected park space. Official publications, glossy projections, and promotional materials—including the cover of Lenexa TownTalk—featured this land as serene, preserved green space. These images were used to help pass the 3/8-cent sales tax initiative, despite the City now asserting the land was never intended to remain parkland. This is misleading and undermines public confidence.

Financially, the handling of this land is equally troubling. In 2015, the City quietly declared the land “surplus.” A 2018 appraisal valued it at just \$38,280 per acre—an amount so low that even the City Manager expressed surprise. The land was never openly marketed, and the public, surrounding residents, and developers were never informed or given an opportunity to bid.

By 2025, after Lenexa property values increased by approximately 80%, the City agreed to sell 17 acres for only \$49,000 per acre—nearly \$20,000 per acre below a reasonable current market value. This represents hundreds of thousands of dollars in lost public value. But this issue is about more than money.

Parks and wetlands protect wildlife, manage stormwater, reduce stress, improve mental health, and strengthen communities. Lenexa residents have repeatedly voiced the need for more trails, natural preserves, pollinator habitat, and family-friendly green spaces. This land already fulfills those needs and serves as an important refuge for wildlife—especially monarch butterflies—and should be preserved for future generations.

We respectfully demand answers:

1. Why was the public not clearly informed when this land was declared surplus?
2. Why did the City allow official planning documents to depict this land as parkland for nearly a decade without correction?
3. Why was the sale never openly communicated or competitively offered?
4. Why is land purchased with dedicated public funds being sold at a discounted rate?
5. Why is the City willing to sell land that the surrounding community has always experienced as their park—and that provides critical monarch habitat?

This is not a “Not In My Backyard” (NIMBY) issue.

This is a “Not In My Park” (NIMP) issue.

Public park land—and vital wildlife habitat—should remain public.

We urge the City of Lenexa to halt the rezoning and sale of this land and to preserve it in its entirety as public park and natural space—now and for future generations.
