#### MINUTES OF THE MAY 7, 2024 LENEXA FOUNDATION BOARD MEETING COMMUNITY FORUM, 17101 W 87<sup>th</sup> STREET PARKWAY LENEXA, KS 66219

# CALL TO ORDER

President Sayers called the meeting to order at 7:13 PM.

# **ROLL CALL**

Board members Karlin, Eiterich, Charlton, Nicks, Arroyo, Williamson, Denny, and Herron were present with President Sayers presiding.

Staff present included Beccy Yocham, Executive Director; Todd Pelham, Deputy City Manager; Mike Nolan, Assistant City Manager; Scott McCullough, Community Development Director; Sean McLaughlin, City Attorney; Jennifer Martin, Secretary; and other City staff.

# **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Board member Nicks made a motion to approve the October 10, 2023 Lenexa Foundation Board meeting draft minutes and Board member Eiterich seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

1. Lenexa Foundation 2023 Annual Report

Beccy Yocham, Executive Director, provided some background on the Lenexa Foundation ("Foundation") since this is the first meeting for several of its members. She said the Foundation was established in 2017 as a 501(c)(3) organization and operates for the benefit of the City by collecting donations and using them for City programs. The Foundation can also engage in fundraising activities and is controlled by the City, making its relationship similar to that of a parent and subsidiary. The Board consists of the City Council members, with the City Manager as executive director, the CFO as treasurer, the City Clerk as secretary, and the Mayor as board president.

Ms. Yocham, outlined the process and standards for the Foundation's annual report, which details its financial condition and is made publicly available on the City's website. She explained that the Foundation has several sub-funds, including those for arts, special events, fire, memorials, parks, and police. Contributions of cash or property valued at \$20,000 or less can be accepted by the treasurer, while larger contributions or real property must be approved by the Board. Similarly, funding requests of \$20,000 or less can be approved by the treasurer, while larger requests require Board approval.

Ms. Yocham said the Foundation cannot accept contributions from individuals or entities with matters pending before the City that could create a conflict of interest or appearance of impropriety. For donations over \$1,000, a vetting process is conducted to ensure no pending matters exist. She noted there is also a policy in place for vetting questionable donations.

Ms. Yocham presented a summary of the Foundation's 2023 annual report, highlighting donations and funding activities. In 2023, the Foundation received nearly \$65,000 in donations, with approximately \$30,000 coming from two anonymous donors. Some donations to the Arts Fund were tied to economic development agreements, which require companies benefiting from incentives to contribute a percentage to the Foundation. The Parks and Recreation Fund received several donations for the Black Hoof disc golf course.

Ms. Yocham said the Foundation granted nearly \$16,000 in total for the year, with \$12,500 directed to the disc golf course and \$2,282 allocated for memorials, such as benches and trees, honoring specific individuals.
