Mr. Huntsinger reported the following:

- Trail connections are being identified through the Trails Alignment Study. We currently have the consultant working on our top 5 connections. They will get us rough budget costs for each section which will be used to build the trail program within the CIP. The first sections will be Buffalo Meadows to Black Hoof Park, along Clare Road from Prairie Star Parkway to 83rd Street, as well as along all of Monticello Road from Prairie Star Parkway to Freedom Fields.
- Work begins on holiday lights the first of October.
