Welcome to the Lenexa Lazers!

Welcome back all Lazers and their families and a big HELLO to all new families! Please read through the following information carefully; it contains a lot of information you will need this swim and dive season.

Registration: Please complete registration and Waiver Forms for each child joining the team. Registration is on a first come, first serve basis through the City of Lenexa. **Failure to register with the City of Lenexa will disqualify an athlete from participation.** If the roster is full, your athlete may be placed on a waiting list and will be allowed to join the team at the coach's discretion or as spots open.

Registration begins Monday, April 1, 2026, at 8am online www.lenexa.com, or in person at the Lenexa Community Center (13420 Oak Street), or at the Lenexa Rec Center (17201 W 87th St Pkwy).

2026 Fees:

Swim Team Only \$125/resident, \$160/non-resident

Dive Team Only \$125/resident, \$160/non-resident

Swim and Dive Team* \$170/resident, \$210/non-resident

For families with three or more members involved in this program, there is a family discount of \$5.00 per child. The discount is available for immediate family members only. Registration must take place in person to receive the discount. All athletes will receive a team t-shirt and all swimmers will receive a swim cap.

Refunds: if you require a refund, please contact the Lenexa Rec Center. Any refunds requested will be issued by the City according to their refund policies. All refunds will be charged a service fee of \$5.00.

Late Registration: Registration deadline is May 10th. Registration submitted between May 11th - May 20th, will incur a late fee of \$20.00 and t-shirt size will not be guaranteed.

SwimTopia:

Swimtopia is the hub for Lenexa Lazars. This includes meet registration, parent volunteer sign ups, important information on practice times, and any updates. Accessible on the web or mobile app. Every family will create one account at: <https://lenexalazars.swimtopia.com/>

App Options:

- Download the free mobile app and have notifications on for important instant updates.
 - These updates will also go to your email as well.
- Upgraded paid version is available for more features including digital heat sheets.

Statusfy:

The Statusfy is handled by Lenexa Parks & Recreation's notification system. This service is easy to use and allows you to receive event and program cancellations, facility closures and notifications instantly via emails, text alerts, a free app or online status updates. Please use this to find information such as practice and meet cancellations or rescheduling. Swim and Dive Teams are listed separately.

Notification Options:

- Free mobile app: Download the Statusfy app from your app store. Once installed, search for "Lenexa" and favorite the ones that apply: Lenexa Outdoor Pools, Lenexa Parks & Rec, Lenexa Rec Center.
- Email/Text: Visit Rainoutline.com and search for "Lenexa." Select the program for which you would like to receive notifications, and choose the "Email & Text Alerts" option. Enter your email address or 10-digit phone number and subscribe to the program area.
- Website: Visit Lenexa.com/Park to see current statue list.

General Information

Pre-Competitive Swim Program: Your swimmer must be between the ages of 5 and 13 years of age as of June 1 to be eligible to swim in this program. This program is not a substitute for swimming lessons. Your swimmer will be coached in stroke technique, but they should already have general knowledge of freestyle and backstroke. The pre-competitive team is intended to refine competitive swimming strokes and prepare swimmers for the competitive team.

Requirements: Athletes should have completed swim lessons and be able to swim freestyle competently for 25 yards with their face in the water, without touching the bottom of the pool, and competently swim backstroke for 25 yards without touching the bottom of the pool. Children will not be allowed to swim if they do not meet these requirements.

Competitive Swim Program: The competitive team consists of swimmers between the ages of 7 – 18 years of age who are proficient at swimming the length of a 50-meter pool. Younger swimmers may be accepted upon the approval of the Aquatics Specialist.

Requirements: Athletes should have completed swim lessons and be able to swim freestyle competently for 50 yards with their face in the water, without touching the bottom of the pool, and competently swim backstroke for 50 yards without touching the bottom of the pool. Children will not be allowed to swim if they do not meet these requirements.

Swim Test Requirement: Athletes who are new to the pre-competitive or competitive swim team must attend a swim test at the Lenexa Rec Center to ensure swimming ability. These can be completed after registration.

Swim Test Dates:

- Monday, April 20th 5:15-6:30pm
- Wednesday, April 29th 5:15-6:30pm
- Wednesday, May 13th 4:30-5:30pm

There are three placement possibilities (*please respect coaches' evaluation of your swimmer's skill level*):

- Promotion to the competitive team
- Remain on the pre-competitive team
- Request to transfer to swim lessons if unable to swim without assistance

Competitive Dive Program: The competitive team consists of divers between the ages of 6– 18 years of age. Divers must be able to swim confidently and dive in order to compete in the league.

Age Groups/Eligibility: Placement in age groups will be determined as of June 1. Competitive swimmers are grouped according to the following: 9&U, 11&U, 13&U, 15&U, 18&U. Divers are grouped the same as swimmers, but also include the 7&U age group. The Lenexa Lazars teams are open to any swimmer/diver who has not reached their 19th birthday before June 1.

Practice & Meet Attendance Policy: If your athlete is unable to attend practices during the week, they may not be able to participate in the meet that week. Please keep in mind that practice attendance plays a role in meet participation. If an athlete is unable to attend practice or a meet for any reason, please send an email to Richard. Please make sure your athlete has transportation to and from practices; although coaches are present slightly before and after scheduled practices, they have a schedule to maintain. Please make sure you arrive promptly to pick up your athlete and/or they are aware of how they are getting home.

Behavior Policy: The coaches will talk with the Lazars about appropriate behavior during practice and meets. If a swimmer or diver has received a verbal reprimand about inappropriate behavior, the coach will talk to the

parent/guardian in person and/or an email will be sent to the parent/guardian. We want the swim & dive team to be a safe and fun activity for everyone. If your child has received a reprimand, please review the email and discuss this with your child. Each athlete's behavior affects the entire team.

The pool is closed to the general public during practice times; siblings, parents, friends, etc. are not permitted to utilize the pool during this time.

Mail Boxes: Every family will have a folder in the file boxes. These mailboxes will be used to distribute ribbons after the swim and dive meets, along with any other important pieces of communication from coach, parents, or administration. Lazars is not responsible for missing medals or ribbons. Nothing will be held more than one week following the All City Meets. Please make arrangements to pick up awards shortly after All City Meets.

Inclement Weather: Do not leave your athlete at the pool without transportation if there is any question of threatening weather. Severe will require the coaches to cancel practice; no exceptions. Please make plans to have your swimmer picked up immediately in the event of dangerous or bad weather.

Canceling Practice: Practices will consider pool water temperature and weather prior to practice. Practices will be canceled at the Head Coach's and City of Lenexa's discretion.

Dive Team: (practices are divided by enrollment not age group)

- Dive Group 1: Monday through Friday 8:30 a.m. - 9:45 a.m.
- Dive Group 2: Monday through Friday 9:45 a.m. - 11:00 a.m.

Meet Information

Sign-ups to attend and participate in meets will be completed through SwimTopia three business days prior to the meet. Athletes will only be allowed to participate in meets if they have signed up for the meet ahead of time and are eligible to participate.

- Pre-Competitive swim meet sign-ups will be due the Wednesday before
- Competitive Swim meet sign-ups will be due the Monday before
- Dive meet sign-ups will be due the Thursday before

Pre-Competitive Swim Meets: Pre-competitive swim meets will be conducted Saturday mornings. Warm-ups begin at 8 a.m. and the meet starts at 8:30 a.m. Please see the [Facilities and Team Schedules](#) for locations and schedule.

Competitive Swim Meets: There are five competitive swim meets during the summer on Thursday nights. Please see the [Facilities and Team Schedules](#) for locations and schedule.

Stretching begins at 5:05 p.m. and warm-ups at 5:15 p.m. The meet starts at 6 p.m. Swimmers who have not checked in by 5:30 p.m. will be scratched from the meet at 5:45 p.m. Heat sheets will be available for purchase for home meets the night of the meet for \$1 each, subject to each city's ability to provide them. Heat sheets are also available online for a fee.

All-City Swim Meet: This is the final meet of the season. The swimmers who qualify for this meet will be those with the three fastest times in each stroke by age group. If your swimmer has one of the five top times, be aware that they might be heading to All-City. Details on times will be available during the season from the hosting pool.

Dive Meets: There are five competitive dive meets during the summer on Tuesday nights. For meets, divers in the 7U, 9U and 11U groups should check in with the coaches between 5:15 p.m. - 5:30 p.m. at the hosting pool. Warm-ups begin at 5:30 p.m. The meet starts at 6:00 p.m. with the order of events moving from youngest to oldest age groups. Divers in the 13U, 15U, and 18U age groups should plan to arrive at the hosting pool around 6:15 p.m. and will have a separate 30-minute warm-up after the completion of the 11U events. Please do your best to arrive at warm-ups on time as it is in the divers' best interest to properly warm-up before competition. Divers will be scratched from the meet if they have not arrived prior to the beginning of their event. Please see the [Facilities and Team Schedules](#) for locations and schedule.

All-City Dive Meet: This is the final dive meet of the season. All-City divers are selected based on the average of their top highest meet scores throughout the season. Divers must dive in at least two regular season meets to be eligible to be selected to dive at the All City Dive Meet. Some coaches' discretion may be used, and younger divers may be given the opportunity to "dive up." Details on times will be available during the season from the hosting pool.

Ribbons: Ribbons are awarded to all pre-competitive swimmers for participation, and ranking times/scores for the competitive Swim and Dive teams. Ribbons are placed in the family folders at Sar-Ko-Par Aquatic Center within 1-2 business days of the meet. **The Lazars are not responsible for lost or misplaced ribbons or All City Awards.**

Equipment and Supplies

T-shirts: This year's t-shirt will be distributed during the first several days of practice and is included in the registration fee. Please mark it with your child's name to ensure it does not get accidentally taken. The shirt will be worn for picture day and at all meets. Sizes are not guaranteed for late registrations.

Goggles and swim caps: Goggles are required for all swimmers. Swim caps are included with the registration fee for the swim team. Swim caps are optional at practices. However, swimmers should plan to wear a Lenexa Lazars swim cap at all swim meets. It helps the coaches and the spectators to identify their swimmers. A Lazars swim cap will be handed out with the team t-shirts in the first couple of days of practice. Additional caps may be purchased through Nicole for \$10.00. Swim Bags: Please have your athlete store their belongings in a swim bag, clearly marked with their name. A lost & found box is located at the front desk swimming pool; lost items will not be kept for more than 1 week.

Swim Suits: All swimmers need to wear a swim appropriate suit for practice and meets.

Volunteers

Volunteers: The Lenexa Lazars cannot run without volunteers. All families are required to volunteer at three swim/dive meets throughout the season. **In order for an athlete to be eligible for All City this minimum must be met.**

No prior experience required unless noted below. This team requires volunteers to help run it – please volunteer even if you have never volunteered or helped with the swim team before.

How to Sign-Up to Volunteer:

When you register your swimmer for the meet in SwimTopia, you can also sign for the volunteer at that time. Volunteers will mostly be needed at home meets, but occasionally will also be needed at away meets.

Volunteer Jobs

- **Announcers/Meet Starter:**
 - Swimmers: Announces swimmers to step up onto the block and start the heat using the starting system.
 - Divers: Announces diver's name, dive number, dive and degree of difficulty for meets.
- **Card Collectors:** Collects cards from the timers and judges, takes them to the computer operator. This position can be completed by a child 8 years or older.
- **Clerk of the Course:** Ensuring swimmers are in the correct chairs behind the blocks for their event. This position works with the Pit Boss.
- **Computer Operator:** Responsible for inputting swim times during meets.
- **Head Timer:** Responsible for ensuring timers are ready and communicating with the starter for the next heat. They also start two stop watches for every heat as a back up for a timer issue/failure to start.
- **Hospitality:** Responsible for distributing water for coaches and volunteers at home meets.
- **Judges:** Judges swimmers' starts, strokes, turns, and touches at meets. Training required for this position.
- **Mailbox Awards:** Position filled the following practice day to place ribbons in athletes boxes.
- **Pit Boss:** Ensure swimmers are in their correct assigned seats and move up heats on time for their events and placing them in block and heat order. Swimmers sit in behind the blocks leading up to their event. This position works with the clerk of the course.
- **Sharpie:** Writing swimmers events on swimmers' arms. You must sign up for another job in order to sign up for this job.
- **Meet Volunteer Coordinator:** Responsible for finding the volunteers that signed up for jobs and making sure they go to the correct spot to help, but also finding volunteers for spots that didn't get filled.
- **Score Writer/Adder:** Jobs work together to add all score cards and keeping the score sheets in order.
- **Timers:** Times at meets. No experience required and best view at the meets.
