The Parks and Recreation Department has been offered the donation of a bench at Centennial Park with a plaque.

This request is from Mrs. Mary Guntert to donate a new bench at Centennial Park. The Guntert family owned this land from 1955 to 2002. Mrs. Guntert wishes to honor her family's long history with the property as the area continues to evolve. The proposed bench is on the northeast side of the future park along the Clear Creek Trail.

The total value of the donation is \$1,300, which includes installation by the Parks Department of the bench, concrete pad, and a honey bronze plaque. The attached picture shows the bench location.
